Classroom Guidelines and Expectations

7. Anyone not meeting Mr. Haynes' expectations will be required to come in after school to raise their level of performance to adequate before the next rehearsal. Mr. Haynes has the ability to leave anyone home from festivals. Missing a festival would devastate one's grade.
