Black Hills Energy will award approximately 15 scholarships of \$1,000 each to Kansas students whose parents are customers of the company. Students at your school who meet the following guidelines may apply for the scholarships:

- The applicant must plan to attend an accredited college or university to obtain a bachelor's or equivalent degree requiring at least four years of higher education. The student may attend a two-year institution initially, but must plan to transfer to obtain a bachelor's or equivalent degree.
- The applicant must rank in the top 25 percent of his or her class **or** score 21 or higher on the ACT **or** 980 or higher on the SAT.
- The applicant's parents or guardian must be a customer of Black Hills Energy. They may be a residential customer or the owner or operator of a commercial or industrial account.
- Relatives of employees and retired employees of Black Hills Energy may not apply. We define relatives as spouses, children, grandchildren, brothers, sisters, stepchildren, foster children and in-laws.
- Applications must be submitted by **March 18, 2011**.
